## Exercise 117

For the following exercises, convert each angle in degrees to radians. Write the answer as a multiple of $\pi$.

$$
330^{\circ}
$$

## Solution

Convert to radians by multiplying the given angle with the appropriate conversion factor.

$$
330^{\circ} \times \frac{\pi \text { radians }}{180^{\circ}}=\frac{11 \pi}{6} \text { radians }
$$

The degrees cancel, and only radians are left in the numerator.
