Exercise 117

For the following exercises, convert each angle in degrees to radians. Write the answer as a multiple of π .

Solution

Convert to radians by multiplying the given angle with the appropriate conversion factor.

$$330^{\circ} \times \frac{\pi \text{ radians}}{180^{\circ}} = \frac{11\pi}{6} \text{ radians}$$

The degrees cancel, and only radians are left in the numerator.
