
Exercise 53


Given the following graph,

- (a) Evaluate f(0).
- (b) Solve for f(x) = -3.



Solution

The values are found from the graph. f(0) is the y-value associated with x = 0, and f(x) = -3 is asking for the x-value(s) associated with y = -3.



- (a): f(0) = 1
- (b): $x = \{-2, 2\}$
