## Exercise 53

Given the following graph,
(a) Evaluate $f(0)$.
(b) Solve for $f(x)=-3$.


## Solution

The values are found from the graph. $f(0)$ is the $y$-value associated with $x=0$, and $f(x)=-3$ is asking for the $x$-value(s) associated with $y=-3$.

(a): $\quad f(0)=1$
(b) : $\quad x=\{-2,2\}$
